DISCUSSION

This project replaced 1,970 lineal feet of water line on Vista Drive off of Fern, 675 lineal feet of water line on Russ from Harrison to Dolbeer Street, and extending the water line on 13th Street from West Ave to East Ave with new PVC C900 pipe. The above areas will also get new valve clusters, new water services, new meter boxes, and unused services will be abandoned. Additionally, there are 13 various location throughout the City that will received new valve clusters.

This project was brought before Council on May 3, 2022 to approve \$1,500,000 in funding for construction and construction management services and awarded to the project to Wahlund Construction for the construction bid amount of \$1,223,075. During the course of the project, five change orders were executed to account for changes in the scope of work. The change order resulted in an increase to the project cost of \$1,347,649.77 for construction, bringing the final project amount for construction and

construction management services to \$1,453,301.02. Increases in the project costs were covered by contingency.

Staff has determined that the work specified in the contract has been completed in substantial conformance with the Plans and Specifications. Therefore, staff recommends that Council accept this project and authorize the filing of a "Notice of Completion" at the Office of the County Recorder.
