DISCUSSION

This project consisted, in general, of the decommissioning and deconstruction of an outdated sewer lift station. A new gravity sewer main was horizontally directionally drilled (HDD) approximately 1,200 feet to terminate at a lower sewer main, which then ties directly into the Martin Slough Collector gravity sewer main. The new gravity main is fusion welded high-density polyethylene (HDPE), creating a continuous pipe with no joints, that runs through a gulch in City owned property and across a private parcel as well. A utility easement was obtained as part of the project over said parcel. The removal of a lift station will reduce maintenance costs to the City, as well as negate the need for a generator to be towed to a remote location during a power outage.

This project was brought before Council on March 15, 2022, and was awarded to Wahlund Construction for the construction bid amount of \$217,800 with an additional 20% contingency for a total of \$260,000. Changes were made to the connection of the existing manhole to the new gravity main, and a one of the existing mains to the station was repaired. In all, change orders increased the project total by \$22,770 for a new project total of \$240,570.00, well below the approved amount.

Staff has determined that the work specified in the contract has been completed in substantial conformance with the Plans and Specifications. Therefore, staff recommends that Council accept this project and authorize the filing of a "Notice of Completion" at the Office of the County Recorder.
